


Figure (1): Development of the Global Knowledge Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (2): Development of Pre-University Education Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (3): Development of Vocational and Technical Education and Training Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (4): Development of Higher Education Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (5): Development of Research and Development and Innovation Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (6): Development of Information and Communication Technology Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021).




Figure (7): Development of Economy Index for Arab Countries During the Period (2017-2021)




Figure (8): Development of Enabling Environment Index for Arab Countries During the period (2017-2021).
